GRAND ASSEMBLY OF TEXAS
TEXAS DRESS CODE ADDENDUM – ELECTED AND APPOINTED
GRAND OFFICERS

PURPOSE:

This addendum applies to all Elected and Appointed Grand Officers and does not take the place of the adopted Texas Dress Code for all active members of Texas IORG. It does, however, reinforce Grand Officer acceptance of the current dress code per the Contract signed when accepting the Grand Appointment, as well as the agreement to adhere to the noted items stated in the Rules and Guideline for Elected and Appointed Grand Officers.

GENERAL APPEARANCE:

In addition to items noted in this section of the Dress Code for all members, Grand Officers are reminded of the agreement to the following:

- Being extremely mindful of the required length of skirts
- Being extremely mindful of low cut or other inappropriate styles, always being appropriate for our members
- Visible tattoos must be covered. Body piercing (excluding no more than 2 pairs of ear piercings) are not appropriate.
- General Grooming:
 1. Hair should be freshly shampooed; is to be “natural” in color and worn back from the face with long hair worn behind the shoulders. Barrettes are acceptable to accomplish this.
 2. Make-up should be tastefully applied (do not over apply). Nails should be clean and polished with a “natural” or light pastel color.
- Gloves or head coverings (large bows, headbands, hats or crowns) are not to be worn with “white” attire. Narrow headbands are allowed and should be the same color as the hair.
- Clothing is to be clean, neat, and freshly pressed with shirts worn “tucked in”.
- Proper skin color undergarments must always be worn and not be visible.
- Heels should be no higher than 2” and cleaned of any scuff marks.
- No Hoops under a full skirt.

- All Floor Officers and Flag Bearers must purchase the Grand Assembly formal. All other Grand Appointments may purchase the Grand Assembly formal. Formals are to be hemmed 1" from the floor with the same type of hem as when the original garment was received.
- Texas Uniform (official polo shirt and black skirt) worn with black flats or heels that are no higher than 2 inches = The Complete Texas Uniform. Grand Floor Officers will have a special polo shirt each year which becomes part of their Texas Uniform.

Good hygiene is essential in achieving a neat, clean, and acceptable appearance. Remember that the appearance of a Grand Officer is a model for all members to follow.
