## *“You Can Be Anything” Grand Assembly Session*

### **Texas Grand Assembly - June 19 - 21, 2026**

For security reasons, *all attendees* must register for Grand Assembly and display Registration badge at all events. Those attending Installation only are not required to register. We ask that our out-of-state visitors **NOT register** through a Texas Rainbow Assembly. **Please complete your own Grand Assembly Registration online**, designating your affiliation. This will eliminate the need to carry credentials in your Registration badge. Only those eligible to attend a regular meeting of Rainbow may attend “closed” Grand Assembly Sessions. Those not eligible will be designated by a badge of a different color. Family members and friends may attend “open” Grand Assembly events. If in doubt, please ask ahead of time.

All sessions and meal events will be at the Waco Convention Center, 100 Washington Avenue, Waco, Texas 76701. This packet contains all the information you need to make Grand Assembly and hotel reservations. A Tentative Schedule is also enclosed to help you in making your plans.

Transportation: There is an airport in Waco, with most flights connecting through the Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport. It is possible that arrangements can be made for approved Texas IORG adults to pick you up at the Waco Regional Airport (ACT), if you contact us with your schedule. Our Grand Assembly Chairperson, Ms. Jo D. Dibrell will have a committee of individuals for this, and she can be reached at Jo\_dd@yahoo.com.

On Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup>, the Grand Cross luncheon is at 12:00 p.m., with the Grand Cross ceremony immediately following. All Masters of the Grand Cross of Color must present their Grand Cross Identification card for the Grand Cross luncheon and Degree. Our General Banquet is at 5:30 p.m., followed by the “open” Ceremonial Grand Opening.

Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup> will be a full day with a business session in the morning, initiation session at 1:30 p.m., the Memorial Service at 5:30 pm followed by our evening session which will include the Cavalcade of Flags and a special fun event to follow. Our Grand Assembly Session concludes on Sunday, June 21<sup>st</sup>, with the Grand Installation of Officers at 3:00 p.m.

Supreme Officers will receive complimentary registration and be our guest for the Grand Cross Luncheon, General Banquet and Saturday Awards/Fun Night. Grand Worthy Advisors and Grand Representatives to Texas will receive complimentary registration and be our guest at the General Banquet. We do ask that all guests submit a Registration form by June 1<sup>st</sup> so that we may prepare for your attendance. All attendees should complete and submit forms to the proper Chairpersons. You will enter “guest” on the form rather than a number, for registration and specified meals, as applicable. Payment for meals/events not covered by Texas IORG must be sent to the appropriate individual, as designated. Please arrange your hotel reservations with our Housing Chairperson, noted on the hotel form, or arrange them through your Assembly host.

**If** you are **rooming** with a local Assembly, indicate the Assembly name on the Grand Assembly Registration form. In this case, you will NOT need to submit the Hotel Registration form, as the Assembly will include you with their girls. Please follow up with the Mother Advisor, however, to make sure you have been included! **Otherwise, you are responsible for making your own hotel reservations.**

It is important that registration be completed online even though we may hear from you by phone. We realize that your appointment may not be known before our deadlines and we will do our absolute best to accommodate you, but we do need your registration form. Should you need help with any reservations after the deadline, please contact Jo D. Dibrell, and you will find her contact information at the bottom of this letter. She will be happy to assist you.
