GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING ARTICLES BY Email:

- 1. Articles must be attached as a Word document (.doc file)
- 2. Size of font should be 10 pt. Garamond, left hand alignment
- 3. Headlines should be in 14 pt., all caps, bold, or equal size in your choice of font
- **4.** Pictures must be in a .jpg file. Pictures emailed should have the highest resolution If picture is 4 ½, use 72 dpi. If picture is less than 4 1/2, use 300 dpi
- **5.** In the Subject area of the email: Please type: *TRN* Article for (name of assembly or section)

Tips for Writing Articles for the TRN – 2022-2023

Quick "Pointers" to help the Editors

When writing the words *Texas Rainbow News* or *TRN*, in any fashion – in a document or in email form - always use **Bold** and *Italic*. For <u>your</u> personal emails, please make a habit of also using Bold and *Italic Texas Rainbow News* or *TRN*. This is good training so others will use the proper form.

Write **headlines** in **Garamond** 14 pt., or an equal size in *your choice* of fonts. Write the **body** of an article in **Garamond** 10 pt., always – no option on this font.

First paragraph: Include the following in your article:

Who- who was there, Grand Officers, special guests, etc. If you use assembly names, please add the # of the assembly. Normally, **only** the number of the assembly is used and **not** the word "Assembly"; i.e. Houston #8 *not* Houston Assembly #8

What- What was the point of the meeting or event

When- When did the event take place

Where- Where was it

Why- Why did they have it

And possibly **how**

Use **third person (he, she, they**) as much as possible when writing articles. Try not to use the words **"I" or "we."** You are reporting what **happened** at the event, not how the event made a person/persons feel.

Paragraphs are left hand justified. No indention.

If you have photos of the event, do not put them in the article. Send them as a separate attachment in .jpg. It is helpful if you label your photo with a descriptive **name** rather than send labeled with only the **number** of the photo. It **is** permissible to attach your photos with your article to ensure correct placement of the photos you send; however, they must **also** be sent in .jpg format. Clip art is very welcome and encouraged. These make articles more interesting, especially if there are no photos!

Articles should be carefully proof-read for spelling and grammatical errors. Use spell-check. Be sure articles are clear and concise!

Write **End** (in red) at the end of each article. That will help us to know it is complete. \odot This is also a good journalism practice.

Deadlines must be firm. Please do not ask for extensions.

BE SURE, you have added the following emails to your personal approved contact list – so they don't end up in your Spam folder! They need to communicate with you! Please check your email daily.

Assembly name and number <u>or</u> Girl's name (as applicable to the article) is always in **Bold** Use Garamond 10 pt. for articles; left-hand justified. Headlines in 14 pt. Garamond or equal size in another font for variety and interest
